Also I'd like to note that the railroad runs through our tract and that it also provides temporary floral resources.



Canal that runs along blocks 17, 16, 15 - provide water source, temporary habitat and nesting area.

\* Canal that runs along blk 35/34 - provides water source, temporary habitat + nesting area.

- Blocks 1-4: all bee habitat including temporary floral resources, permanent nesting habitat.
- Blocks 30, 29 also have solar panels that also provide bee habitat including temporary floral resources + permanent nesting habitat.
- BLK 1: has a small little reservoir that hosts a variety of trees, temporary floral resources + permanent nesting habitat.

• Blooming forage weeds that can be found in this ranch include: flame, mallard, mustard, Chamomile, fuchsia vine, Scotch thistle, alkali mallard, london rocket, Srepan's pine, "alkali weed" (has pretty purple flowers), common chickweed, sunflowers, dandelion

• On the north end of blocks 27, 32 that run along road by railroad - this section along road property that has temporary floral resources + permanent nesting habitat.
