*WHEREAS, pollinators contribute to the environmental health necessary for maintaining robust, biodiverse ecosystems in New Mexico; and*

*WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico has a long-standing commitment to managing and conserving wildlife habitats and public lands, including our unique forests and grasslands; and*

*WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico actively supports producers through conservation assistance programs that promote sustainable stewardship, including the protection and maintenance of pollinators and their habitats on both working lands and wildlands.*
