NEW HAMPSHIRE POLLINATOR WEEK
JUNE 18-24, 2018

WHEREAS, pollinator species such as birds and insects are essential partners of farmers and ranchers in producing much of our food supply; and

WHEREAS, pollination plays a vital role in the health of our national forests and grasslands, which provide forage, fish and wildlife, timber, water, mineral resources, and recreational opportunities as well as enhanced economic development opportunities for communities; and


WHEREAS, pollinator species provide significant environmental benefits that are necessary for maintaining healthy, bio-diverse ecosystems; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Hampshire has managed wildlife habitats and public lands such as New Hampshire forests and grasslands for decades; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Hampshire provides producers with conservation stewardship, including the protection and maintenance of pollinators and their habitats on working lands and wild lands; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **CHRISTOPHER T. SUNUNU, GOVERNOR** of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim **JUNE 18-24, 2018** as **POLLINATOR WEEK** in the State of New Hampshire, and call this to the attention of all citizens.
