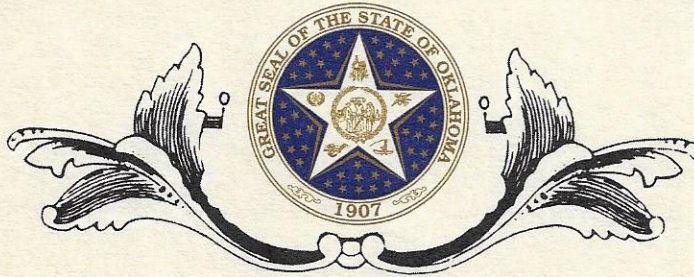

Whereas, the state of Oklahoma has managed wildlife habitats and public lands, including state forests and grasslands, for decades; and

Whereas, pollinator species provide substantial environmental benefits that are necessary for sustaining healthy, biodiverse ecosystems; and

Whereas, Oklahoma is committed to conservation and environmental stewardship, including the protection and maintenance of pollinators and their habitats on both commercial and natural land; and

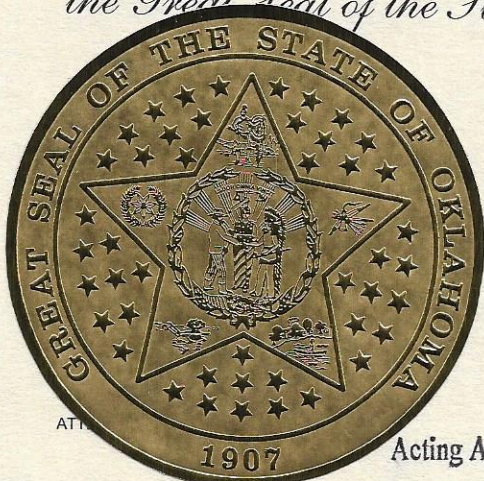
Whereas, Oklahoma Pollinator Week is an opportunity to acknowledge the economic and environmental contributions of pollinators in our state;
